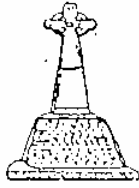

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF BRYMBO COMMUNITY COUNCIL HELD ON TUESDAY 10TH MARCH 2026 AT BRYMBO SPORTS AND SOCIAL COMPLEX.

Present (Chairman) Cllr P Rogers (also CBC)

Brymbo Ward- Councillors D Ashworth, W Martin, J Phelen, S Rawlinson and P Rogers.

Tanyfron Ward- Councillor C Harris.

Bwlchgwyn Ward- Councillors K Peacock, M Peacock and J Williams.

County Borough Councillor P Rogers

Apologies Cllrs J Barton, J Garston (ML) G Hughes and K Mathews.

The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 10th February 2026 were confirmed as a true record and signed by the Chair.

DECLARATION OF INTEREST-None.

The Chair thanked Cllr Phelen for his work in getting the light on Min y Graig restored after a lengthy battle.

2 COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCILLOR'S REPORTS

CBC Brown and CBC Wellens were not in attendance and no apologies had been received. The Clerk had not received a monthly report from either CBC.

CBC Rogers opened by saying that the lease on the Sports and Social complex was in the process of being renewed by WCBC. WCBC wished to dispose of the Lodge Community Centre, and as a result a community association had been set up to look at either leasing or purchasing the building. Members agreed to give the group their full support. With regards to the new school in Brymbo, CBC Rogers said that the plans were near completion, and the planning process was due to begin in May/June.

3. ROADS

CBC Rogers asked members to email him with a list of roads that needed resurfacing in Brymbo and Tanyfron asap as these needed to be forwarded by himself to WCBC. Bwlchgwyn Councillors were asked to contact CBC Wellens in order that he put forward any in Bwlchgwyn that needed resurfacing.

4. TANYFRON COMMUNITY GOVERNOR

The Clerk had received an e mail requesting a new Governor for Tanyfron school. That afternoon she had also been advised that a new Governor was needed for Brymbo school.

Cllr Harris and Cllr Martin put their names forward and the Clerk would send details of what the role involved.

5. SLA PLAY AREAS

The SLA for play area maintenance had been received from WCBC. The Clerk told members that there was a 2% increase for 2026-2027. This amounted to £12410.00 including VAT. Members agreed that this was good value for money, and it had been budgeted for. Cllr Martin proposed, and Cllr Ashworth seconded that BCC continued to fund the maintenance. A vote was taken. All were in favour.

6. INTERNAL AUDIT

JDH Business Services had contacted the Clerk regarding the internal audit for 2025/2026. They had asked if the CC were happy for them to continue with their services. Cllr M Peacock proposed, and Cllr J Williams seconded that the CC should continue to use JDH as they were more than satisfied with the service provided. A vote was taken. All were in favour.

7. PRIDE IN PLACE

The Chair told members that he had booked meetings for the following three Wednesdays to discuss the Pride in Place scheme.

The Clerk had received the application form and the criteria for the funding and had circulated it to members. Any project delivered would need 3 quotes. The award for BCC was £44117.64. This was excluding VAT. Members agreed that all 3 villages should benefit from this funding. If worked out proportionally using the number of voting adult the figure was:

Brymbo 2405

Tanyfron 787

Bwlchgwyn 669

These figures equated to Brymbo receiving £27485.00, Tanyfron £8999.00 and Bwlchgwyn £7632.00. Members agreed that BCC would have to select and administrate the projects. The Chair asked for a resolution that BCC would lead on the project and the application procurement and proportion by electoral division be followed. This was proposed by Cllr C Williams and seconded by Cllr K Peacock. A vote was taken. All were in favour.

8. PLANNING

CBC Rogers said that he was extremely disappointed that planning enforcement at WCBC had not responded regarding the issues on Mount Zion and Llewelyn Road. He had received no update.
